As a leading scholarly database, it provides access to acclaimed full-text journals, magazines, and other valuable resources. Academic Search Premier contains bibliographic data of 17,150+ journals, of which 15,300 are peer-reviewed, and 4,750+ with full text. PDF backfiles to 1975 are available for nearly 140 journals. More than 2,200 active full-text journals are indexed in Web of Science or SCOPUS. Academic Search Premier offers access to collection of more than 67,000 videos from the Associated Press,

covering a wide variety of topics. Database covers the areas of science such as biology, chemistry, physics, psychology, engineering design, religion and theology, new technologies etc. Database is updated daily.



Business Source Premier, the most widely used business research database, covers a variety of business discipline and provides full text of 2,150+ academic journals. Business Source Premier includes the full text of key research publications from 1965, cited references are searchable for the resources published from 1998. Nearly 580 active full-text journals are indexed in Web of Science or SCOPUS. In addition, it includes market research reports, industry reports, country reports, company profiles, SWOT analyses and collection of more than 67,000 videos from the Associated Press, covering a wide variety of topics.



Regional Business News is a supplemental database for customers of Business Source Premier, providing ultimate coverage for more than 70 full-text business publications from the United States and Canada. Key resources include newspapers, magazines and newswires with full-text content coverage spanning more than 20 years.



MasterFILE Premier contains full text for nearly 1,600 periodicals covering general reference, business, health, education, general science, and much more. This database also contains full text for nearly 440 reference books, over 73,000 primary source documents, and an Image Collection of over 1.7 million photos, maps & flags. Database offers backfiles for key publications (*American Libraries, Foreign Affairs, History Today, Library Journal, National Review, Saturday Evening Post,* etc.) dating back to 1917.

Database provides nearly 320 scholarly full-text journals including *Creative Nursing, Issues in Mental Health Nursing, Journal of Advanced Nursing, Journal of Child & Adolescent Psychiatric Nursing*, and more.



Health Source®: Consumer Edition **Health Source: Consumer Edition** is a rich collection of consumer health information. This resource provides access to nearly 80 full-text, consumer health magazines, including *American Fitness, Better Nutrition, Fit Pregnancy, Harvard Health Letter, HealthFacts, Muscle & Fitness, Prevention, Vegetarian Times, and many others.* This database also includes searchable full text for current, health-related pamphlets and more than 100 health reference books.

In addition, it offers television and radio news transcripts from major networks (CBS News, CNN, CNN International, FOX News, NPR and more).



MEDLINE®

MEDLINE provides authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and much more. Created by the National Library of Medicine, MEDLINE uses MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) indexing to search citations from over 5,600 current biomedical journals in 60 languages.



ERIC®

Education Resource Information Center (ERIC) provides access to education literature and resources from journals included in the Current Index of Journals in Education and Resources in Education Index. ERIC contains more than 1,600,000 records and links to more than 631,000 full-text documents from ERIC, back to 1966. Source types include journal articles, books, conference papers, curriculum guides, policy papers and more.



GreenFILE™

GreenFile offers well-researched information covering all aspects of human impact to the environment. Its collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles includes content on the environmental effects of individuals, corporations and local/national governments, and what can be done at each level to minimize these effects. Topics covered include global climate change, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling, and more. The database provides indexing and abstracts for more than 880,000 records, as well as Open Access full text for more than 13,000 records.



LISTA, Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts™ indexes more than 600 journals, as well as books, research reports and more. Customers can review information on more than 5,000 most frequently indexed authors and their publications. Subject coverage includes librarianship, classification, cataloguing, bibliometrics, information retrieval, information management.



Teacher Reference Center provides indexing and abstracts for more than 220 peer-reviewed journals. Database covers a variety of topics of interest to teachers, including: assessment, best practices, continuing education, elementary education, higher education, literacy standards, school administration, science & mathematics, teacher education and more.
